

Selected Library Resources for Medical Students & Residents

MEDLINE via **PubMed** –

To search for *Evidence Based Medicine*, choose "Clinical Queries" in left sidebar.

MEDLINE via **Ovid** –

In addition to MEDLINE you may search in *Evidence Based Medicine* databases.

Choose: All EBM Reviews – Cochrane DSR, ACP Journal Club, DARE, and CCTR.

Most EBM databases are full-text. Online help is available.

To find articles on health science topics, **use the links to PubMed, Ovid and other databases from the Library Home page**. Using the home page links, plus signing on to authenticate at the key  when off campus, will enable linking out to licensed full text e-journals directly from the chosen database. Please contact the library if you have any questions concerning searching or need advice on a topic.

To find specific electronic journals:

- ✓ **Look for TU Link!** **TU Link help:** <http://library.tulane.edu/tulink.swf>
- ✓ An **E-Journals List** of *Licensed* Tulane journals is available online: **HINT:** Use the PMID (PubMed identifier) to locate a specific article online.
- ✓ Check the **Library Catalog:** (Locate print and electronic resources, including journals, books and other media in any Tulane library.)
- ✓ **If the Library does not own a specific resource, you may request an Interlibrary Loan.** Sign up to register and use the **ILLiad** service. If you have questions contact the Library (medref@tulane.edu or 988-5155).


To find online information in health science books for basic clinical questions:

- **Access Medicine** – Includes online versions of Harrison's, CMDT and Lange texts.
- **MD Consult** – Database of clinical texts, online journals, patient handouts, & guidelines.
- **R2 Library** - Full text access is available for selected books, such as Washington Manuals.

Point of Care Resources & Evidence Based Medicine:

- **DynaMed** a point of care reference resource, focused on primary care.
- **ACP's PIER©** an evidence-based, point of care tool from the *American College of Physicians*. This *STAT!Ref* service includes ACP Medicine, ACP Surgery, drug information, & coding information.
- **GIDEON** an infectious disease & epidemiology resource.
- **Up-to-Date** a database with clinical information. (No remote access) - Available only in the Tulane Health Sciences Center & TUHC.
