MEDLINE via PubMed –

To search for *Evidence Based Medicine*, choose "Clinical Queries" in left sidebar.

MEDLINE via Ovid –

In addition to MEDLINE you can search the Cochrane Evidence Based Medicine databases.

Choose: All EBM Reviews – Cochrane DSR, ACP Journal Club, DARE, and CCTR.

Most EBM databases are full-text. In Ovid you can search multiple databases simultaneously.

To find specific electronic journals:

- ✓ [E-Journals List](#) - An alphabetic list of *Licensed* Tulane journals is available online.
- ✓ [Library Catalog](#).- Locate print and electronic resources, including journals, books and other media in any Tulane library.
- ✓ [ILLiad](#) - **If the Library does not own a specific book or journal, you may request an Interlibrary Loan.** Sign up to register and use **ILLiad**, a free, online service. If you have questions contact the Library medref@tulane.edu or 504-988-5155.

To find online information in health science books for basic clinical questions:

Access Medicine – Search multiple or individual texts including: *Williams Obstetrics*, *Harrison's Online*, *Goodman & Gilman's Pharmacology*, *Current Diagnosis & Treatment Obstetrics & Gynecology*, and the *Lange Library*.

MD Consult – A search can encompass journal articles, book chapters, patient handouts, drug updates. Resources include: *Gabbe: Obstetrics: Normal and Problem Pregnancies*, *Katz: Comprehensive Gynecology*, *Obstetrics and Gynecology Clinics* and *Pediatric Clinics of North America* and the *American Journal of Obstetrics and Gynecology*.

STAT!Ref – Clinical texts and drug information Included ACP Medicine, ACS Surgery, drug and coding information.

Point of Care Resources & Evidence Based Medicine:

DynaMed - A clinical reference resource focusing on primary care.

ACP's PIER© - An evidence-based tool from the *American College of Physicians*.

Up-to-Date - A database with clinical information. (**No remote access**) - Available only in the Tulane Health Sciences Center & Tulane and Tulane Lakeside Hospitals.
